



## Lower Salmon River Canyon (Sample Schedule)

Schedule in Mountain Time Zone

### Day Before Trip

Pre-Trip Meeting 8:30 pm at Hotel McCall,  
1101 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, McCall, Idaho

We will make initial introductions, pass out waterproof duffel, go over the itinerary, arrange for picking up everyone the next morning, and cover any last minute questions or adjustments for the trip.

### River Trip--Day 1

Departure to Salmon River, 8:00am (Meet the bus to load duffel and leave town)

We recommend you eat breakfast before we leave. The scenic bus ride will be about 2 hours plus any restroom stops we make.

Arrive at the Salmon River (Pine Bar): 10:00am  
Unload bags, have Safety Talk, and get on the river.

Lunch: 12:00pm\*

Arrive in Camp for Evening: 4:00 to 5:00pm\*

Hors 'd oeuvres and Cocktails: 6:00pm\*

Dinner: between 7:00pm to 8:00pm

On the first day of the trip we will warm up by running a number of Class II rapids with large waves. Be ready to get wet and have a wonderful time. There will some opportunity for fishing both from the boats or in camp. We may be into camp a little earlier in the afternoon, depending on availability of campsites.

### River Trip Days 2 & 3

Breakfast: 8:00am\*

On the: 10:00 to 10:30am\*

Lunch: 12:00pm\*

Arrive in Camp for Evening: 4:00 to 5:00pm\*  
(Appetizer and Dinner times same as Day 1)

On Day 2 we enter Cougar Canyon, a narrow canyon with steep rock walls and fun rapids with big drop offs, including our first Class III rapids, Bodacious Bounce and Half & Half. With more rapids to come, on Day 3 we will float through Snow Hole Canyon which is another precipitous canyon containing the Class IV Snow Hole rapid, characterized by it's steep drop and house size boulder which creates an exciting ride! We will visit an old Chinese rock house built with a beautiful view, which provides us with a look into a time when the canyon was more than just a recreational trip.

### River Trip Day- Day 4

Breakfast: 8:00 am\*

On the River: 9:30 am \*

Lunch: 12:00 pm\*

Arrive at Take-out and load onto bus: 1:00pm\*

Day 4 usually begins from the Snake River in Hells Canyon. Typically we need to make a lot of miles on the last day of the trip, so the majority of the time is spent floating on the water and watching for wildlife. We often see Rocky Mountain Big Horn sheep in this part of the Canyon. Depending on time constraints, lunch will be served either before we reach the Take-out or at the Take-out before you leave on the bus.

\*\*\*\*NOTE!! ALL times quoted from the time we leave the Put-In at Pine Bar are approximate, can be very flexible, and depend upon activities we choose to do during the day, water levels and conditions, and the weather. We have snacks and drinks available throughout the day as needed.
